## **Increase in Carrier Security Charge (SER)**

Dear Valued Customers,

This is to notify that effective 1st January 2010, MCC will be increasing the Carrier Security Charge (SER). The revised SER is applicable for the whole scope of Intra-Asia trade\* excluding Taiwan.

Carrier Security Charge was implemented in 2004 in response to costs associated with security initiatives. Experiencing direct operational costs as a result of the ISPS Compliance Security charges were introduced. The value of this charge which is \$6 has not been changed since 2004. Due to increase in administrative expenses and currency fluctuations, the quantum is revised accordingly.

The revised SER quantum is as follows:

	<b>Charge per Container</b>
Current Amount	USD 6
Effective 1 <sup>st</sup> January 2010	USD 9
