Dear Valued Customer,

Changes introduced in Amendment 35 of the IMDG code

We would like to inform you of changes introduced in amendment 35 of IMDG code. It will be mandatory to ship cars as hazardous cargo Class 9 UN No 3166.

Cars will only be acceptable as non hazardous if it's declaration in writing that the cargo is comply with Special Provision 961 of the IMDG code. For regular bookings we can accept a single letter with a validity of 1 year.

Suggesting wording for the declaration letter:

"We confirm that the vehicle offered for shipment complies with the requirements of IMDG code Special Provision 961 and that the fuel tank(s) of the vehicle is empty and installed batteries are protected from short circuit"

This new requirement is effective from 1st January, 2012.
